



# Language Assessment Policy

### Learning Your Level

To register in LCC courses, you must complete an English test and let LCC know your choice of course, start date and time. If you attended LCC before but have been away for more than 1 year, you need to be tested again.

Admission level requirements for specific courses cannot be waived; all students are required to take a level test to determine their level and placement in appropriate classes. If you have recent LINC, IELTS or TOEFL test scores or graduated from an English-speaking university, you can show us your scores or diploma as evidence of your level. We will make a copy for your file.

#### Advancing to higher ESL levels

Moving from one level to the next is based on progress in class and abilities in all areas. If students want to change their level, they must speak to their instructor.
